Granted by the town of Sudbury unto John Woodward layd out by Deacon
Eliot In Execut and Mr Joseph noyso two acres and three quarters and
rods of low meadow land lying att Castell hill brook neare unto his house
which two acres and three quarters and 4 rods is to be and remain unto
said John Woodward his heirs and assigns for ever In lieu where of
the said John Woodward hath layd down four acres on the side of his field
for a highway to pass to the Court meadows and is by ye said Surveyor layd
marked and is for ever to remain att the towne disposal See this grant
att a publick town meeting march ye 5: 9:37 Entered in town book of Orders

The towne of Sudbury hath Granted John Collar unto John Collar two acres and
quarters of an acre of Land by way of exchange for two acres of Land and
of an acre that the said John Collar hath layd down of his own Land
Soe Exchanged was layd out by Deacon John Haining and James Burman & John
which was appointed by the town for that worke the one side the other and is
to remain for ever Except that the said John Collar should not be able to
make a good title of what hee hath delivered to the town & soe then
town shall enjoy their own Land againe the said Land given to said
Beginning att a whet oake upon which and runneth four score Rods south ward on
Sudbury lyn and in breadth five Rods and a half fairly marked See this Grant
