Also granted and layd out to Mr William Colham in the year 1658
one hundred acres of land be it more or less in the two miles last
granted the town of Sudbury being the eight and fortieth lot
and litch in the fourth and fouthwest squadron having the Land
of Mr John Rogers on the north and the Land of John Parmenter
tenor nor oute fouth the sayd lot of Mr Colham being bounded
at the west by the widdownes and bounded at the east end by the
middle gage way joining to our first squadron of lots
