lying in the great Ponds on the side towards Concord and lyeth
between the meadow of John Streetman on the north side
and the meadow of John Maynard on the south side of it

1643 Robert Darvill of Sudbury being appointed by the true lawfull Attorneys of
Robert Hoordam by virtue of a l^{tr} of Attorney bearing date the 9th of
June 1642 gave shuld alienate deliverat & confirmed unto John
Noyes of Sudbury twenty Acres of upland be the same more or less
w^{ch} land was formerly granted to the said Robert Hoordam, & l^{tr} v^{er}
himself w^{ch} the west end butting to the river, the east end to the town
common & joynt to the South side of the land of the said John Noyes
the said John Noyes bought of & gave Goodman the house & couplet of the
said Goodman containing by estimation five acres or thereabouts
lying between the couplet of the said John Noyes & the couplet of
the said Goodman the consideration w^{ch} of the said John Noyes shuld be
w^{ch} the said Goodman Goodman the said land of upland between
the brook & the brook being part of the proud division of upland
of the said John Noyes w^{ch} the said land lyeth at the end next to
the brook & joynt to the land of Robert Darvill

1644 The said John Noyes his third division of upland being a land out
at the Hill & all the Munnings of upland w^{ch} m^r Noyes bought of
the said Munnings to the town all but five acres w^{ch} lyeth at
the foot of the hill on the south side of the Hill between the
foot of the Hill & the usual gate to the lower end of the gulfe
the rest is layd out in several parcels & places as followeth
eight acres w^{ch} on the west side of the River over against the
great butting Southward towards west meadow Northward to a
swamp granted to John Wood & reserved to the town & laynd
Christy's acre next on the west side of Goodman's Hill Southward
butting towards the gate that goeth to the meadow of Northward
towards the west end of the town swamp of the eight way to the
towards the highway

four acres more joynt Southward to the land of John Haynes on
the west side of the River & to the land of Thomas Noyes and
Northward to the land of Walter Haynes & reserved to the town
w^{ch} found acre m^r Noyes gave to John Haynes
the said acre butting Northward towards the gulfe & reserved to a
swamp granted w^{ch} the said m^r Noyes gave to John Haynes
and acre more lying & being wholly compassed in by the meadow
of John Haynes next to the great meadow w^{ch} acre is all
gave to John Haynes
