The the Subscribers Laid out a Town way on the east
Side of Sudbury River beginning at the Great County
road at Sandy Mill & called running Easterly to land
formerly belonging to Silas Goodenow now in the
possession of Caleb Wheeler Bounded Northerly on
formerly granted ^{by the Proprietors} and laid out to Ebenezer Goodenow
from the Land mentioned formerly belonging to Silas
Goodenow to the County Road it being Land left by
the Proprietors for the Benefit of said Land
said way is two Rods wide Southerly from said Bound
