

enjoy a parcel of Meadow containing by Estimation four acres
lying on the East Side of the River between the Meadow of Mr.
Waldgrave & the river, wch parcel of meadow was formerly
granted to the said Walter Haine as part of his first division
of meadow. Witness Hugh Griffin.

Granted to Walter Haine a piece of meadow containing by Estimation two
acres & half or thereabouts lying in a piece of meadow wch runs
out of y^e ~~parish~~ meadow Southward joining wth y^e meadow of Henry
Loker. Also three acres more of meadow lying Southward of y^e
said meadow in a piece by it self. Also one acre more of meadow
lying on y^e Northside y^e said two acres & half of meadow by it self.
Also eleven acres more of meadow lying in y^e ~~parish~~ meadow between
y^e meadow of Edward Goddard on y^e West & a Tod of Pyes on y^e
East. Also ~~two acres of meadow being part of y^e said division of meadows~~
as the same more or less lying on y^e West side of y^e River next to y^e meadow
of y^e said Walter Haine called flag meadows & lyde next to
y^e ~~river~~ way that leads to Walter Haine's plantations. Also
three acres of meadow the said Walter Haine gave to Solomon Johnson
of y^e said Soloman Johnson gave unto Hugh Griffin.

Also six acres of meadows betwixt said more or less lying in y^e
meadows next adjoining to y^e meadows of John Mares w^{ch} are
now granted to him for allways to y^e said division of meadows
next to y^e ~~river~~ way that leads to y^e said meadows.
Also Walter Haine layd downe twenty acres of upland w^{ch} was
formerly layd out to him between the land of Thomas Mares &
y^e said meadows & the town gave him liberty to take it up
where w^{ch} was layd downe in several places & parcells as followeth
four acres of upland lying on y^e North East end of Goddard's
parish.

Also ten acres more of upland lying between y^e wallnutt
tree & y^e plantations meadows & lyde Street East from y^e path that
leads to y^e plantations meadows.

Also six acres of upland lying by the side of Thomas Mares
lying between the higgs way & the great River meadows w^{ch}
the said Walter Haine gave to y^e same in the name of Thomas Mares.
Also three parcells of upland w^{ch} are part of y^e forty acres w^{ch}
is before recorded in the 4th section of y^e above twenty acres
that remaineth there due to Walter Haine butte to a swamp
towards y^e said meadows on the North & South side lying to y^e
land granted to Mr. Peter Mares now in y^e possession of
John Haine.

Also granted and layd out to Walter Haine in the year 1653
one hundred and thirty acres be it more or less lying and being in
the two miles last granted the town of Sudbury being the
third lot and being in the first squadron having the lands granted
to Thomas Mares on the South and the lands granted to William
Loker but now in the possession of Mr. Loker on the North
being bounded at the East end w^{ch} the six way & the way
wide and the five miles first granted to the town of
Sudbury being bounded at the West end by the middle
six way and fourth squadron.
