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At a Meeting of the Selectmen of Sudbury Feb 12 1768
Laid out a highway to the farm belonging to the Widow Josiah Noyes
Ducas. (At the Request of Mr James Haynes & others) for the
Benefit of D^d farm the Bound of D^d way are as followeth
vizt begining at a white Oak at the Corner of the field
formerly belonging to Mr. David Maynard Ducas, and running
Northerly to a pitch pine Tree marked and so on to
another pine Tree marked & to D^{its} & to D^{its} & to D^{its}
then to a small white Oak and so to D^{its} & to D^{its} and so to
a maple tree near the Slough then Turning Easterly to
a Gray Oak and so to a white Oak and so on to a Large
Crooked white oak near the Corner of D^d Hairs Land &
and so onto the Corner of D^d farm where the Road is now
Trod D^d Road is Laid on the South Easterly Side of D^d Bound
and is laid one Rod wide from the Road leading from
Mr. Zebadiah Maynard Down into Gulf Neck until it comes
to the Corner of D^d farm.
