and lay out by Dea John Hamer and Sath John Rutter two ards of madow
James Hamer and three quarters of madow lying in long meadow betwix the madow of
Exchange madow and Joseph Noite and the meadow formerly granted to Eliab Rogers: which
said 2 ards 3 quart of madow bee it moor or los as it is in state by marked
trees is to bee and remain the said James Hamer his heirs and Successors
for ever In: Luo whereof the said James Hamer hath laid down two
ards and three quarters of madow in a strap of madow on the north
est sid of panty bridge having the madow of ^{ant} Peter King on the north
and the madow of Thomas Plimpton on the south which 2 ards and 3 quarts
bee the same moor or los is to bee and remain to the town proper
use and Dispose for ever
