one hundred and thirty acres of land be it more or less in the
towne miles last granted the town of Sudbury the said one
hundred and thirty acres lyeth in the south east and first square
and is the first lot and fourth to the north on the south
and the land of Thomas Mays on the north and butchery at the
east end to the eight way by the roads wide joining to the first
miles last granted the town of Sudbury and butchery on the
west end to the eight way and fourth west square
