Have mutually and friendly for the future peace
and quiet of us and our Heirs and Assigns for ever
hereafter agreed and settled Bound between our Land
in manner following beginning at the most East
Corner of John Clark's Land being a small Sassafras
marked on the west side and north with three small stone
laid at the root thence running westerly a straight line
to a pine tree marked standing in the fence being
a partition line between the ^d John & Phineas thence
running the same course to a pine stump being
formerly a mark Tree in or by the fence as it now
stands from thence as the fence now stand till it
comes to the most Norwest Corner of the ^d Phineas
Land next to Thomas Plymtons be the ^d Phineas
to hold and enjoy the Land Southerly of the ^d fence
as it now stands from the pine stump westerly
and the ^d John to enjoy and hold the Land Northerly
from ^d pine stump as ^d fence now stands in witness
