

Middlesex St. - Sudbury August 19th 1794 -

Whereas Complaint hath been made to us, the Subscribers
two of the Justice Viewers of said Sudbury, by Rowland Boagle
of Sudbury, Gent^l and Says, that, Abner Stone, of Framing
-ham, Yeoman, whose Land, adjoins to his, in the River
Meadows (so called) in Sudbury, and, joins upon him, from
the River to Shore, utterly Refuseth, to divide, Erect, or Repair
any part of the fence, on said line - we therefore after
Due Notice, to each person, Repaired to the place complain-
-ed of, and made the following division, as by Law we were
Empowered to do, Beginning at the Northwesterly corner Be-
-tween said Boagle, & Stone, and found the line from Shore
to River, to be seventy six Rods, we Sett off, to said Boagle
thirty eight Rods, ~~upon~~ on the Westerly part of said line,
and Sett off, to said Stone, thirty eight Rods, upon the
Easterly part of said line, which is each mans part, or
Share, to Erect, and Repair, forever hereafter, and you are
heroby Required, by Law, to erect your part of said fence
within Six Days, from the date hereof. —
