we the subscribers have Laid out a Highway beginning
at the County Road leading to Lancaster in the East Thatt
Road Highway is Called Two Rod wide between the Land
of Elijah Price and Sam^l. Orsborn being Land left for a
Highway Bounded westerly on the face of the said Elijah
Price it Comes to the meadow of Daniel Loring and so on
through said Daniel Loring meadow westerly Bounded
on Land of the widow Brigham untill it Comes to a Stake &
Stones which is the Southwesterly Corner of said Daniel Loring
Land the said way is Two Rods wide through said meadows

also Granted & Confirmed to the said Daniel Loring his
Heirs and Assigns for ever Two Rods through the Easterly
Part of said Daniels meadow being Land Left for a
Highway in full satisfaction for the afore said Two
Rods Laid out through the westerly End of said
Daniels meadow
