

Middlesex to Sudbury June 22^d 1764

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whereas Mr Asher Cutler of D Sudbury Yeoman has
Complained to us John Nixson and Sam^l Eaton two of
the fence viewers of the Town of Sudbury and say that
Mr Sam^l How of D Sudbury Gent whose land adjoynes
to his utterly neglects and Refuseth to Divide fence and
to Erect or make any ~~new~~ fence on the Division
Line Between them and we have repaired to the place
Complained off by the D Asher Cutler and the D Sam^l
How having had due notice thereof and was present
and then Did refuse to Divide fence with the D Asher
Cutler or to Erect or Repair the same

then we went on the Said line and made the following
Division as by law we were Empowered to do and
began at y^e northerly End of D line and measured
the same and found it to be seventy six Rods and we
set off to the D Asher Cutler Thely Eight Rods on
the northerly End of D line and we set off to the D
Sam^l How Thirty Eight Rods on the southerly End of
D line which is to be each ones part or Share of
the D fence to Erect and Maintain for ever here after
