

644 Granted to Thomas Bigby for a well parcel of Meadow containing by appraiser
 hundred or there abouts being famous for being by the Dyke Swamp and route
 by called or known by the name of the Dyke Swamp meadow and being the parish
 running by the Dyke. And they gave to a parcel of Meadow ground to Edward King
 lying on the Westmost side of the brook between the said meadow and the village
 of William Brown.

Sudbury 7th Decr 1770

At a Meeting of the Selectmen of said Town we the
 Subscribers have laid out a Highway side Road
 through the Land of Asahel Whilon leading to Saml
 Puffers Junr beginning at the County Road leading from
 Sudbury west meeting house to Concord and is bounded
 Northerty by Saml. Eatons field fine as the fence
 now stand and so on untill it comes into the Road
 leading to said Saml. Puffers

Also Discontinue Grant and Confirm to the said Asahel
 Whilon his Heirs and Assigns for ever that part of
 the Old Road leading from Sudbury west meeting house
 to said Puffers side Road wide as far as it goes through
 said Whilon Land in full Satisfaction for the aforesaid
 Road
