

36 Sudbury Dec^r 12th 1754 Then Laid out for Mr^r Sotham Browne
fifteen Acres of Land, in the Easterly Thirty Rod wide way, in
Sudbury Lying on the pine hill, Southwesterly of Cedar Swamp
and bound do follows, Beginning at a heap of stones the sou-
therly Corner of a Lot, formerly Laid out to Mr^r Benjamin
Barron Deeds, and run from ^{to} heap of stones South seventeen
Degrees, West thirty Nine Rods on the old Town line to a heap
of stones, ^{run from west twenty degrees North thirty Nine Rods to a heap of stones} then run North Eighteen Degrees thirty Minutes East
Eight Rods & half on a Slip of Land two rods wide left for a
way to a heap of stones, then runs North twelve degrees
thirty minutes, West thirty rods & half on a Slip of Land
to a heap of stones, then runs North Seventeen Degrees, East

viz: Beginning at a White Oak Tree the North Easterly Corner
of Land formerly laid out to Mr^r Samuel Willis & runs from
thence East eight Degrees, South Eleven Rods & half on
Land belonging to the Heirs of Micah Barron Deeds
to a Stake and heap of stones, then runs South Seventeen
Degrees, West forty Nine Rods & half on the old Town Line
to a Black Oak Tree, then runs North fifteen Degrees
West thirteen Rods on Land formerly laid out to Mr^r
Sam^l Willis to a Gray Oak Tree, then on a Land thirty
Six Rods to the bound first mentioned
