

Sudbury May 7th 1778

I have laid out unto Ezekiel How of Sudbury and to his Heirs & Assigns forever, by Order from the Committee chosen & empowered by the Town of Sudbury; for to Sell the Land - lying & being in the two thirty Rods wide High Ways (so called) lying & being in the Land called the New Grants in T^o Sudbury, one Acre & sevenly one Rods of Land - Situate lying & being in the Westerly: 20: Rods wide High Way - being one of the two above named or mentioned High Ways: and is bounded on the Northeastly corner of this old Homestead Land; and from thence South 18: deg: & about 20: Minutes; West 20 Rods by Land claimed by T^o How on the West, to a rail fence and heap of Stones - Then turning and Northeastly running, as the said rail fence now stands: 16: Rods, to a corner of the fence; And from thence Northwardly by & on the Eastwardly Side of the Stone Wall: 12: Rods, to a Stake and Stones - And then turning & Westerly running, by & on the Southwardly Side of some Land, laid out to Ezekiel Parmenter & Jedidiah Parmenter: 14 Rods to the heap of Stones first mentioned - And is further bounded as may more fully appear by a Plan thereof here to Annexed - All which is Submitted to the Town of Sudbury for their Approbation and confirmation: &c

I have laid out unto Paltiah Parmenter of T^o Sudbury & to his Heirs and Assigns forever, by Order from the Committee, chosen & empowered by the T^o of Sudbury; for to Sell the Land lying & being in the two thirty Rods wide High Ways, so called, lying & being in the Land called the New Grants in T^o Sudbury - Three Acres & 14 Rods of Land, Situate lying & being in the Westerly: 30: Rods wide High Way, being one of the two above mentioned High Ways - and is bounded - beginning at a Stake & Stones; being in the Westerly line of the T^o Westerly: 30: Rods wide High Way; and from thence running: N. 18 $\frac{1}{2}$: Deg: E. on T^o line, Six Rods & a half - Then turning and running Northeastly, as the fence now stands: 20: Rods - And then turning & Eastwardly running, as the fence now stands: 6: Rods - And then turning & Southly running: 22: Rods - by & on the Westwardly Side of the Way or Road - Leading to the West Meeting House in said Sudbury, to a Stake & Stones - by and on the Northwardly Side of a Strip of Land of two Rods wide - Left for a Way to the Land of Deliverance Parmenter; and from thence turning and Westerly running, by & on the Northwardly Side of said two Rods Way: as the Way is now Left (so as it appears by the Plan

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
