

ffor his house lott four acres lyminge betwene Edmond Goodenore on the northside and John Coll on the southside wch four acres is now in the possession of John Coll.

Also five acres of upland being a part of his second addition lyminge upon the flatte upon the east side of the river between Lymbes north and m^r Edward farne. lyminge on the southside to a parcell of land granted to Joseph Carter but now in the possession of m^r Howard and on the northside lyminge to Lymbes north and the west end of it buttynge upon the great river.

Also one acre of meadow in the great meadow lyminge on the southside to the rydders light and to Edmond Goodenore on the northside.

Also three acres of meadow being the eleventh lott in the great meadow lyminge to John Hayman on the west side and to a parcell of meadow granted to Richard Whyte on the east side.

The lands wch William Brown bought of William Parker

four acres given him for his house lott lyminge betwene the house lott of m^r Peter Moxe on the west side and the house lott granted to Anthony Whyte on the east side the south end runnynge to mill brook and northwyl to the huge way that leadeth to the meadow towards bridge point.

Also one acre and a halfe of meadow lyminge in the great meadow betwene m^r Peter Moxe on the southside and Anthony Whyte on the northside.

Also William Brown bought of Anthony Whyte four acres given to him for his house lott lyminge betwene the house lott aforesaid wch was granted to William Parker on the west side and the house lott of Thomas Brown on the east side the south end runnynge to mill brook northwyl to the huge way that leadeth to the meadow towards bridge point.

Laid out to William Brown two acres three quarters of meadow lyminge in the Painted Meadows betwene the meadow of John Budden on the east of the meadow of Robert Durill on the west wch parcell of meadow was his third division of meadow granted him by the town.

1648 Laid out to William Brown two acres three quarters of meadow lyminge on the westside of the river lyminge in a little pece of meadow that goeth out of the southside of ynd meadow to the great river meadow lyminge betwene the meadow of Walter Haym on the huge way that goeth alonge betwene it and the great river meadow. And this was William Parker's third division of meadow. & it parte of the land that William Brown bought of him.

1651 Laid out to William Brown sixe stacion acres of upland & twenty acres of meadow lyminge all in the southwyl parte of the town bounde and is bounde & enclosed ad id hardin defended. All the upland & fourteene acres of the meadow lyminge altogether. And the other six acres of meadow lyminge in
