P. 1 In the Above Plan is one acre and 20 Rods of Meadows
Between the Meadow and Lancaster Road is 1.29 Rods the
Remainder of the Lot is 5 Acres & 11 Rods

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May 1st 1758 Then laid out to Mr Joseph Willin & Obadiah Perry
Eighteen Acres & twenty seven Rods of upland, Lying in Sudbury
in the West thirty Rod wide Way, Lying between Willins
Road & Lancaster Way, and adjoining to both Bounds, as follows
Beginning at a Pump by the Pond, and Run Southerly forty six
Rods on Joseph Willins Land to an Oak Tree Marked Still
bearing the same point Sixty four Rods on Land of Nathiah Par
menters to a Small Pine, by Lancaster Way, then Run Wester
ly on D. Way, Twenty eight Rods to a Small white Oak Marked
Then Run Northerly on a Slip of Land left for a Way till it comes
to the Pond aforesaid, then on said pond, till it comes to the
first mentioned Bound, all which may appear by the above
Plan

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May 1st 1758 Then laid out to Obadiah Perry ten Acres
and Sixty nine Rods of Upland, in Sudbury in the Westerly
thirty Rod wide Way, Lying Between Lancaster Way and said
Perry's House - Bounding as follows Beginning at an Oak Tree
by Lancaster Way, and Run from thence Southerly forty Rods
on S. Perry's own Land, to an Old Pump, still on S. Perry's
Land, Eighteen Rods to a Stake; then Run South Westerly Eight
Rods, on a Way; Leading from Mr Daniel Woodward's to the
Meeting House Eight Rods & half on Common Land (a path
being in the Line) to an old pine tree marked - Then Run
Northerly on the second Range of Lot forty four Rods & half
to a Poplar by Lancaster Way - Then on D. Way thirty Rods
to the first Bound all which may appear by the above plan
