

his horse lott containinge eight acres lyinge between the lande of Robert flourdum on the southside and John Maynard on the north west side of it

Also eight acres of ^{meadow} lyinge between the lande of Robert Dwyer on the southside and John Maynard on the north west side

Also fouenteene acres of meadow more or lesse lyinge between the meadowe of m^r William Hellingum on the south west side and Henry Durtoid on the North east side

Also five acres of meadowe buttynge ^{towards} water towne bounde

Also eighteene acres of upland lyinge on the west side of the river to the same more or lesse lyinge between the lande of the widowes warget and John parmenter sumar.

1643. Granted to Robert Darvill fourte acres & a halfe of upland to the same more or lesse lyinge between the house lott granted to John Knight & the ginge way that leadeth towards the lande of m^r William Hellingum.

Also one acre & a halfe of upland parted from the house lott of the said Robert Darvill by the ginge way, & lyeth between the lande of John Maynard & the towne pound.

Also eighteene acres of upland lyinge on the west side of the river, between the lande of John Blandford.

Also granted and layd out to Robert Darvill in the year 1643 one hundred and twenty acres of land to it more or lesse lyinge in the two miles of land last granted by the town of Sudbury beinge the space and twentye lot and half in the second square havinge the lande of John maine on the south and the lande of Thomas whit on the north and buttynge on the east on the ginge way and the five miles first granted by the town of Sudbury and buttynge on the west on the middle ginge way and the second square
