

May 1st 1758 Then Laid out to Obadiah Perry Three Acres and
Ninty Rods of Upland & Meadow Lying in Sudbury in the
West Thirty Rods wide way Lying near his House; in part for an
Allowance formerly made his Father for a way Laid out in his
Land; and part for S^d Obadiah Perry to purchase of the Town
the whole Bounds Northwesterly on a way Leading from M^{rs}
Daniel Woodwards to the Milling House Westerly on Common Land
till it comes to an Oak Tree marked; thence Running South Easterly
thirteen Rods & half on common Land to a pile Marked, in
said perry's Line then running Northwesterly on S^d Perry's Old
Grant fifty Eight Rods to where we began all which may Ap-
pear by the Above Plan — per Stephen Warner Surveyor

Sudbury November 2^d 1757
I have Laid out unto Jonas Clark Esq^r of Boston & to his Heirs and
Assigns for ever two Acres & 131 Rods of Land by Order of the Town
of Sudbury, Com^{rs} called the New Grants Com^{rs} Situate Lying & being in
Sudbury aforesaid & on the Westerly Side of said Sudbury Riverland
is & lyeth in the Easterly thirty Rods wide High Way so called in the
Lands commonly called the New Grants (having a Barn and some
Orcharding standing & being on the above Lands with some other
Improvements) and is Bounded Eastwardly & Northwardly on Land
left for a High Way, Westwardly on the above Clark's Land which he
Bought of James Fraige & is Southwesterly Bounded on the Land of Job
and Silas Moore in part & partly on Common or otherwise High Ways
and is farther Bounded as may more fully appear by this plan
as it was Surveyed and laid out by John Haynes

Sudbury May 9th 1756 -

I have laid out unto Samuel Knight of S^d Sudbury and to
his Heirs & Assigns forever; By Order from the Committee chosen
and impowered by the S^d Town of Sudbury, for to Sell the Land
Lying & being in the two thirty Rod wide High Ways (so called)
Lying & being in the Land called the New Grants, Six Acres and
a half and twenty Rods of Land; Situate Lying & being in the
Westerly 30 Rod wide highway, being one of the two above
mentioned High Ways & is at & Joyning to the Easterly End of
the S^d Samuel Knight's Homestead Land and is Westerly Bounded
thereon
