

Also granted and laid out to Thomas Goodnow in 1629
one hundred and thirty acres of land to it more or less lying
and being in the two miles last granted the town of Sudbury
being in the fourth and fourth most Squadron being the four
and fortyth lot having the lands of John Bent junior on the
north and the lands of Thomas Symon on the south butting
on the west on the wilderness and butting on the east on
the middle eightth and ninth rods wide and the first Squadron

At a Meeting of the Selectmen September 22 1780

We the undersigned Laid out a Town way on the west Side of
Sudbury River beginning at the Great County Road at Sand Hill
so called running Easterly to Land formerly belonging to Silas
Goodnow now in the possession of Caleb Wheeler Bounded
Northwardly on Land formerly granted by the proprietors
and laid out to Ebenezer Goodnow from the County Road Land
mentioned formerly belonging to Silas Goodnow to the County
Road it being Land left by the Proprietors for the Benefit of
said Land said way is two rods wide Southwardly from
said Bound
