

Sudbury Oct: 19th 1757

Laid out unto Sam^l Brigham of Sudbury and to his Heirs & Assigns for Ever, from and by Order of the Said Town of Sudbury: Committee Called the New Grant Committee Twenty acres of Land Situate Lying & Being in the Easterly thirty Rods Wide Highway so called, Within the Lands Called the New-grants in Said Sudbury Exclusive of a Way of Two Rods Wide where the path now is leading from the West Meeting House in Said Sudbury towards Joseph Willis: Running through the above Named Land, and is Bounded as followeth, Beginning at a Walnut Tree marked, with a heap of Stones at the Roots Standing & Being in Sudbury Old Town West Line so Called, & from thence West 40 Degrees North Nearest Hand 29 Rods to a Stake & Stones, then Turning South 19 d.g. W. by & on the Easterly Side of a Strip of Land of Two Rods wide left for a way running untill it Coms a Cross the above Said premises towards the above Named Joseph Willis & then Turning W. 20 d.g. North Two Rods to Land Belonging to the Heirs of m^r John Green Late of Said Sudbury De: & then Running on Said Lands South 19 d.g. West about - rods to a Stake & Stones on & sumthing Northwardly of the Top of a small Ridge Hill Northwesterly of Lost Pond, then Turning West 20 d.g. South by & on Land laid out to Sam^l Asboul 30 Rods (Saving Two Rods) to an other Stake & Stones, Being in the above Said Old Town West Line so Called & then Turning & Running South 19 d.g. East 110 Rods or thereabouts to the Walnut & Stones first mentioned, & is further Bounded as may more fully appear by this Plan, all which is Humbly Submitted to the Said Town for there Acceptance & Confirmation &c
