Also seaven acres of upland. lyinge between the house lott of William
ward & the lande of Mr William Pollan

Also seaven acres of meadow. lyinge on the north side of the meadow of
Edmond Pire towards Bontord. &c.

Also eight acres of upland lyinge on the north side of the River towards
Bontord lye. lyinge between William ward and John Freeman
a little brooke runninge through the midst of it

All the wherof said lande with all right thereto belonginge the said Solomon
Johnson sold unto William ward and now it is in the possession of
the said William ward.

Also granted and layd out unto Solomon Johnson in the year 1658 one
hundred and thirty acres of land in the two miles of lands last granted to
the town of Sudbury beinge the thirty seventh lot and lyeing in the third
squadron havinge the lands of John Sutton on the north and the lands
of John Coll on the south beinge bounded on the west by the widewnes
and bounded at the east end by the middell way runninge at the east
end of the great pond
