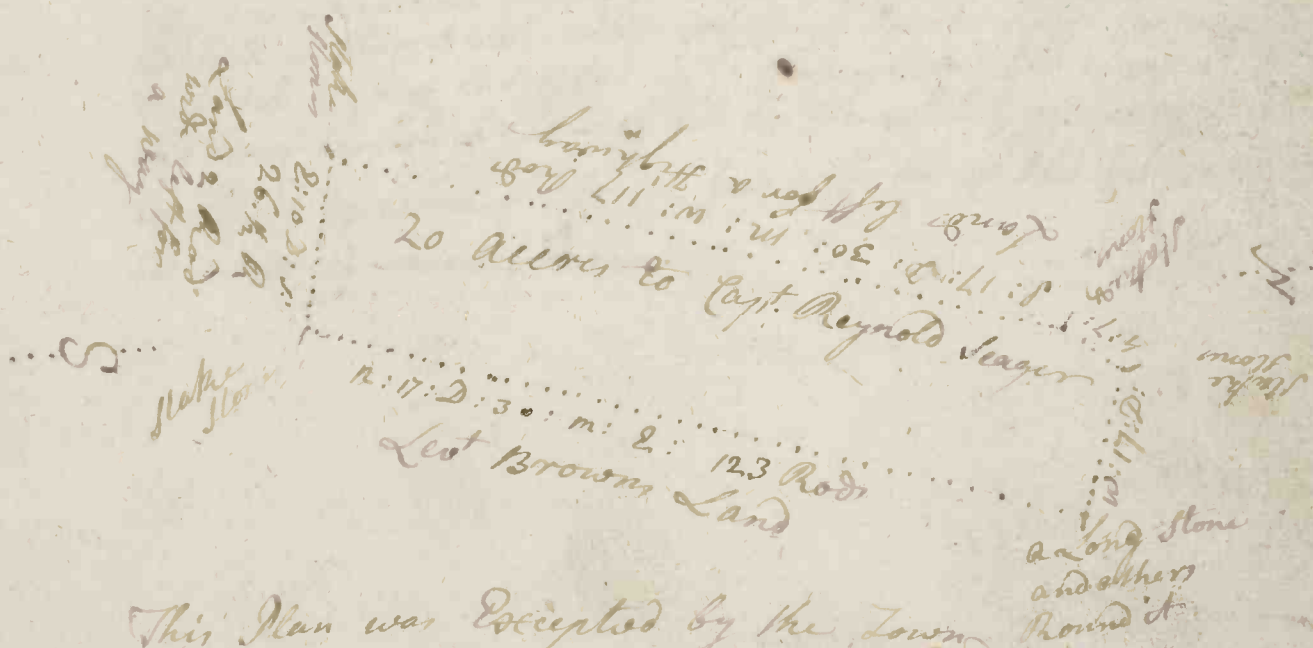


By Order of the Selectmen and } Sudbury June 30 - 1764

by the Desire and at the Request of Capt Reynolds Seager of Sudbury I have Re-surveyed a Certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing Twenty Acres situate lying and being in Sudbury Above said and is in the Land called the New Grants Easterly Thirty Rod wide Highway sometime since Granted and sold by the said Town of Sudbury to the said Reynolds Seager but since the first Survey said Land is found to be in some Part to Infringe on the Easterly Side on some Lands claimed by Lev. Honestill Brown on which I have altered and so removed the Bound of the said 20 Acres something more westerly from off said Brown Claim (but still Remains in the said 30 Rod wide Highway) and is now Bounded Easterly on said Brown Claim southerly and westerly on Land left for Highways and is Northerly Bounded on the Land of Ebenezer Roby Esq. and is further Bounded as may more fully appear by the Plan as Re-surveyed herunto Annexed
