Harmontes Junior.

Also another parcell of upland lyinge oute against the house lott of the
South street containinge by estimation fivie acres the one end butte upon
pyne brooke the other end butte upon millbrooke and lyeth betweene
Andrew Belcher and John Harmontes.

Also eight acres of upland on the west side of the River lyinge betweene
the lande of John Wood and John Maynard.

Also two acres of meadowe lyinge in the great River meadowe lyinge
betweene Andrew Belcher and John Harmontes.

Also four acres of meadowe in the great River meadowe lyinge betweene
the meadowe of Mr William Pellum on the one side and Thomas
on the other side.

Granted to Richard Newton 3 acres of meadow lyinge in a parcell of meadowe
goeth out of ye gulfe towards Concord bounde by ye highwaye betweene ye meadowe
Thomas White & ye meadowe of John Maynard.

Also granted and layd out to Richard Newton in the year 1658
one hundred and thirty acres of land be it more or lesse in the
two last miles of land granted the town of Sudbury, beinge
the twenty fifth lot and lyeth in the second Squadron of lots
neare yon road line havinge by land of John Buddon on the north and
the lands of Thomas Whit on the south beinge bounded by the highwaye at the
east end & adjoininge to the first mile first granted the town of Sudbury
also beinge bounded at the west end by the middle highwaye adjoininge to
the third Squadron of lots the sayd west end of this lot goeth neare
the river at yongasfittasunto.
