

At a Meeting of the Selectmen April 4th 1764
 We the Subscribers at the Request of Henry Smith and Others
 have Laid out a Town way Leading from Mr. Josiah Haywood
 mill to the Town way Leading from Mr. Amos Smiths to Abijah
 Brighams. and the Marks are as followeth Viz. —
 Beginning at a small Pine Tree Marked in Mr. Henry Smiths Land
 Near Acton Line from thence a straight line to another
 small Pine in Mr. Smiths Land from thence a straight line to a Stake
 and Stones by Mr. Moses Maynard field at the End of a piece of Stone
 wall from thence to a small white Oak in Mr. Maynard Land from
 thence to a small Pine in Land belonging to the Heirs of Simon
 Maynard from thence to a Stake and heap of Stones by the Road
 Leading from Mr. Henry Smiths to the West Meeting House &
 on the Easterly side of the way then beginning at a small Pine
 Tree Marked in the Land belonging to Mr. Maynard Heirs and on the
 westerly side of the afore said way from thence a straight
 line to the Northerly Corner of Lephemiah Smiths field
 at a Stake and Stones at the South East Corner of Mr. Smiths
 Land from thence a straight line through Land of John Maynard
 a Mine to a small Pine in Mr. Micah Boukens Land from
 thence a straight line to another small Pine in Mr. Boukens
 Land Near the Road Leading from Mr. Amos Smiths
 to Mr. Abijah Brighams & Marks are on the westerly side
 of the way & the way is Two Rod wide Elijah Smith
