

Granted and layd out to Foster Range in the year 1658 in the two miles
last granted the town of Sudbury that is to say layd out one hundred
and thirty acres of land be it more or less lying and being in the
third Squadron having the landesherry lot on the north and the land
of John Smith on the south the said one hundred and thirty acres of
land being the 2^d lot and lying on both sides of the river called by
the Indians *Pompahtaruck* and the said one hundred and thirty acres
of land is bounded on the west by the extremity of our line and
bounded at the east end by the middellidge way leading to our
second Squadron of lots
