Robert Darvill of Sudbury being appointed by true & lawfull Attorney of
Robert Goodnow by virtue of a tre of Attorney bearing date the 9th of June
1642 gave sold aliened & delivered & transferred unto W^m Kerley of
Sudbury the elder all the lands of the said Robert Goodnow, w^{ch} gave said
Robert Goodnow bought of Joseph Dacast, lying in the town of Sudbury
all right & priviledge hereto belonging or in any wise appertaining
And also thirty dones of meadow & fischeable dones of upland granted
by the town to the said Robert Goodnow lying w^{ch} in the town of Sud-
bury, his alienation & being made of the land delivered unto the said Willi-
am Kerley the last day of the seventh month 1643. And the said Robert
Darvill gave also sold all right & priviledge in commonage belonging
to the said thirty dones of meadow & fischeable dones of upland.
Granted to W^m Kerley the younger eleven dones of upland be the same
more or less lying in the south part of the townes bound joyning to the
north end of the land of John Goodnow & Southward to the common.

(4) 8. 1644. Edmund Goodnow granted to William Kerley in way of Exchange five
towne dones or there abouts on the west side of the river, City dones of Med-
dows in the great river meadow at more at large appeared in the land of
Edmund Goodnow page. 28.

Granted to Will Kerley Jun: two acres of meadow lying in pine meadow on
west side of the river between the meadow of Mrs Hunt & the meadow of Henry
Frome.

granted and layd out unto Lieutenant Amund Goodnow in the years 1658 the
one hundred and thirty acres whiche was granted to William Kerley senior
being the four and thirtieth lot and lott on the third square
having the lands of the heirs of Robert Dacast on the north and the lands
of John woods on the south being bounded at the west by the wilderness
and bounded at the east end by our middle higg way joyning to the second
square
