

His house sett by myd in the South streete betwene Thomas Goodnowe and Richard Norton containinge four or there about with a litle peere of meadow containinge halfe an acre or there about ioyninge to the south end of it buttynge upon the mill brooke the other end of it buttynge upon the highway that leades into the east end of the great meadowe.

Also an addition of upland lyinge upon a north of lande on the southside of mill brooke containinge seven acres or there about lyinge betwene Thomas Goodnowe and Richard Norton the Northend buttynge upon the mill brooke and the south end buttynge upon the brooke whiche is called Wyndbrooke.

Also a peere of meadow containinge four or there about lyinge in the great meadowe betwene Thomas Goodnowe and Richard Norton the one end buttynge upon the highway that lyeth upon the north side of the great meadowe the other end buttynge upon the west meadowe against a parcell of meadowe granted to Mr. Browne the pastor.

Also another peere of meadowe whiche is called the Grange Division containinge eight acres and a halfe or there about lyinge in the great meadowe betwene Thomas Goodnowe and the widdow Waryng the one end buttynge upon the Southeast side of the great meadowe the other end buttynge upon the north west side of the great meadowe.
