The Petition of Samuel Townsend and others for a new highway from Elias Brooks in Stars to William Smith in Duckbury

This petition was presented to the County Commissioners at their meeting holden at Concord upon the third Tuesday of Sept. last as by the record thereof and the order of notice thereon there entered is at large set forth; and thence said petition was continued to the last term holden at Cambridge within and for said county on the first Tuesday of January last when and where said commissioners did adjudge that the new highway in said petition prayed for was of common convenience and necessity and that the same should be laid out according to the law in such case made and provided. And thence said petition was continued to this time for a return of the proceedings of said commissioners in the premises. And now said commissioners make return of their proceedings in the premises— which return follows in these words— Pursuant to the adjunction of the county commissioners for the County of Middlesex made at their January term A.D. 1831 on the petition of Samuel Townsend & others
