for a new highway in Stow and Sudbury. It having been made to appear that all persons and corporations interested therein had been duly notified of the time and place of meeting the said commissioners did on the thirty first day of March A. D. 1831 proceed to locate said ~~new~~ new highway and to ascertain the courses and establish the boundaries thereof as follows viz. Beginning on the southerly side of the old road leading from Stow to Concord at a stake and stones easterly of the dwelling-house of Silas Brooks in Stow and running S. 65° 30' E. over old road extending over Silas Brooks' land on the southerly side seven rods and five links over Ephraim Randals land forty four rods to a stake & stones S. 68° E. over said randals land forty four rods and over William Parker & Co.'s land twenty five & a half rods to a stake & stones S. 54° 30' E. over said company's land twenty eight rods to a stake and stones by the side of a small apple tree marked on the north upper bank of the Elizabeth river S. 46° 15' E. over said company's land about five rods to the middle of said river and Sudbury line, same course over said company's land forty three and one half rods to a stake and stones S. 55° E. over same land fifty nine rods to a small white oak tree marked S. 62° E. over same land and old road five rods to a stake & stones S. 70° 45' E. over same land and old road five rods: over old road and Levinah Wheeler's land twenty rods & eight links: over said company's land and old road fifty seven rods: over Nathan Puffer's land and old road twenty four rods over Elnathan and Jason Haynes land and old road twelve rods to a stake and stones S. 55° E. over said Haynes' land
