

his householle containing by estimation five acres or there about be the same more or lesse lying between the householle of the widdow Hunt on the north side and the householle of Henry Lokar on the south side of it the east end buttynge to the higg way) comynge to the Mill and the west end to the great river meadowe.

Also a parcell of upland lying in the flatts between Lymber necke and m^r Blounts farme containing by estimation eight acres or there about.

Also a parcell of upland lying on the west side of the River containing by estimation stauon acres or there about be the same more or lesse lying between the lande of Edward Goodnowe and William Cartley.

Also a parcell of meadowe containing by estimation two acres three roode or there about be the same more or lesse lying in the great river meadow between the meadowe of widdow Hunt and Henry Lokar.

Also another parcell of meadowe containing by estimation nynt acres or there about whereof two acres next to the River is to serue for a path and landing place for the use of the towne be the same more or lesse lying in the great river meadow between the meadowe of Henry Cartley and the meadowe granted to Edward Gunninge & now in the possession of Peter Wolfe.

1642 Granted to John Goodnowe hertwene downe of upland be the same more or lesse, lying in the souther part of the towne bounde, joyning to a great Rote on the west side of it, to the lande of William Charlyson the north end of it.

Granted to John Goodnowe five downe of meadow, lying in the west meadow on the west side of the River, lying between the meadowe of William Charley & the meadow of John Maynard, & buttynge upon the brooke where it end, & the upland at the other end.

1644 John Goodnowe bought of Thomas Holgar his house & householle, all of the meadowe belonging to the said Thomas Holgar formerly granted him or his hall & thereafter be due unto the said Thomas Holgar by virtue of his first right the beginning of the plantation of Sudbury.

Also John Goodnowe bought of Henry Lokar an downe & calfe of upland lying upon the pine gill, & joyning to an downe & calfe of the lande of the said John Goodnowe lying on the back side of the now dwelling house of the said John Goodnowe of the parcell of land the said John Goodnowe sold calfe an downe to John Viddorke & the same gave liberty to John Viddorke to lay downe the same to the common & take it up upon the plaine before the now dwelling house of the said John Viddorke where he may pith.

79 Also granted to John Goodnowe five downe of upland lying upon the pine flane, joyning to the west side of the lande of widdow Hunt, & the flane buttynge upon the path that leads to Waterhouse.
