

We the subscribers Selectmen of the town of Sudbury have laid out for the use of Josiah Maynes jr a town way as follows - Beginning at a Stake in the northerly side of State Road Ten rods of Silas Conant and running northerly through said Conant's land ten rods to a black Oak tree marked - Thence northerly through said Conant's land nineteen rods to a Pine tree marked to land of Josiah Maynes - Thence northerly through said Maynes land thirteen rods to a Pine tree marked - Thence North - westly through said Maynes land to the South - East Corner of Josiah Maynes jr. land twenty nine rods. Said Road to be one Rod wide and to lie on the westerly side of said course. All damages to be paid by said Josiah Maynes jr. - Which said Road is hereby reported to the town for their acceptance and when accepted and recorded is forever after to be known as a public town way -

Dated at Sudbury this 30th day of April A.D. 1831.
