Also five acres of meadow be the same meadow less lying in the
great river meadow between the meadow of hugh Cynster and
the meadow granted to Joseph Cynster

Also ten acres of meadow be the same more or less lying in the
great river meadow between the meadow of John Wood and the
meadow granted to John Cynster

1642 Granted to Thomas white twenty seven acres of upland be the same
more or less lying in the north part of the town of his parted from
a parcell of meadow formerly granted to John Cynster & now in the
possession of widow ffrost by his gift was hee letted to the widow.

The 18 day of April 1654 Layd out unto Thomab white three acres of
upland lying at the North east end of the land granted to John Putter
for a houseplot & parted from the field wherein John Putters houseplot
lyeth by the said land of John Putter & the three acres of upland is a part
of the third division of upland first due to John Cynster & now belonging
to the said Thomab white

Also layd out to Thomab white twenty five acres of meadow be it more
or less lying in a piece of meadow called the Gulse & lyeth between
the meadow of Mr Peter Wood & the meadow of John Wood this
twenty five acres of meadow is the third division of meadow

Also ten acres of meadow for allowance to it be the same more or less
lying in the meadow between the meadow of Edmund Goodenow &
the meadow of John Moore.

Also layd out to Thomab white seven acres & a half of meadow being the third
division of meadow & lyeth in a piece of meadow that goeth out of the lower end of
the Gulse towards the river & lyeth between the third division of meadow due
to Anthony white now in the possession of Robert Daines & the third division of meadow
of Richard Alderton;

Also twenty two acres of meadow lying in the great river meadow be the same
more or less & lyeth between the about said town & the meadow
granted to Thomab white & the meadow of Walter Haynes this twenty
two acres was granted to John Cynster for parts of what he wanted
in his first & second division of meadow as appears in the other town books
folio 31

Also ten acres of meadow more next adjoining to the twenty two
acres last above specified & this ten acres was granted to Walter Haynes
as appears folio 31 in the other town books, And Thomab white had it
by way of exchange for ten acres of meadow & was John Cynster lying
between the meadow first granted to Richard white & the meadow of
Matthias Howard
