Also a parcell of upland containing by estimation eleven acres or there about be the same more or lesse lying on a north of land on the south side of mill brooke next adjoining to the land of Thomas Brown.

Also a parcell of meadowe containing by estimation five acres and a halfe or there about be the same more or lesse lying in the great river meadow between the meadowe of Thomas Brown & Henry Lokar.

Also a parcell of meadow containing by estimation twelve acres or three about be the same more or lesse lying in the great river meadow between the meadow of John Reddick and the meadowe granted to Thomas Burmaster.

Also a parcell of meadowe in the west meadowe containing by estimation ten acres or there about be the same more or lesse lying on the west side of the meadowe granted to Mr Peter Morfe.

24(8).1643. It is agreed between John Warmenter senior on the one part & Robert Boast on the other part, that whereas the said John Warmenter hath a parcell of meadow lying in the west meadow in Sudbury, containing by estimation on ten acres or there about be the same more or lesse, And the said Robert Boast hath a parcell of meadow lying by Crooked road, joyning to a parcell of meadowe of Edmund Goodnow, containing by estimation nyne acres or there about be the same more or lesse. They the said John Warmenter & the said Robert Boast gave wth a joynt consent exchanged day wth other that is to say, that the said John Warmenter shall for ever enjoy the said parcell of meadow formerly granted to the said Robert Boast. The said Robert Boast shall enjoy the said parcell of ~~the~~ meadowe granted to the said John Warmenter. Witness given unto John Warmenter Junior, John Crooke, Hugh Griffin.

1646.

Granted to John Warmenter senior one & twenty acres of upland lying in South pt of ye Towne Tonde next unto ye South pt of ye lands of Sarahaker widow. Also eight acres & three quarters of meadow lying in ye gutter between ye meadow of William Ward & ye meadow of John Goodnow.

Also granted and layd out to John Warmenter Junior in the year 1648 one hundred and thirty acres of land be it more or lesse in the two miles of land last granted the town of Sudbury, the said one hundred and thirty acres of land being the one and twentieth lot and tick in the second squadron of lots having the lands of Mr Edmund Brown gaftoo on the south and the lands of John manard on the north being bounded at the east end by the higge way, joyning to the five miles of land first granted the town of Sudbury, also being bounded at the west end by the middle higge way joyning to the third squadron of lots.
