

Brought over

The second piece of said new highway being wholly in Sudbury begins at a large stone in the wall on the southerly side of the old highway on Green Hill so called thence running N. 74 1/2° W. one rod on the old road 36 rods and 30 links on land of the wife & children of Abel Smith and 61 rods on land of Gardner & Luther Hunt to the northeast corner of said Gardner & Luther's land said new highway to be on the northerly side of said line & boundaries and to be three rods wide the whole distance —

And it is considered and adjudged by said commissioners that the two pieces of new highway thus laid out and described be and the same hereby are established as and for public highways —

And the term of six months from this second day of October 1827 is allowed for the proprietors of the land over which the same are layed out to remove their fences wood &c. from the same & the term of eighteen months from said second day of October to construct and make the same passable — And it is further considered

and adjudged by said commissioners that the persons whose names here follow sustain damages by reason of laying said pieces of highway over their land in the several sums annexed to their names respectively to be paid to them out of the treasury of said

County of Middlesex on or before the second day of April A.D. 1829
