Also he bought of Hugh Drury 6 acres of meadow lying in the great river w^{ch} meadow on the south side of the river next adjoining to the meadow of John Hem w^{ch} land he sold of meadow Hugh Drury bought of Bryan Glendon.

Also granted to Edward Rice ten acres of upland lying in the south pt of the town bonds northward joyning to the land of Thomas Dorel Eastward to the land of John Bont & westward towards the land granted to the said Edward Rice.
