

his household renting by estimation four acres or there about
to the same more or less lying between the household of Edmund
Rie & the household of John Maynard.

Allso a parcell of meadow renting by estimation eight
acres or there about to the same more or less lying between
the meadows of John Rie and Joseph Daynter.

1643. Granted to Henry Rie six acres of upland to the same more or less lying in
the south part of the town-burrow, butting upon the east side of the Dunstons
farm, & upon the common southward, & upon the north to the highway leading
from Sudbury to the Dunstons farm.

Also granted to Henry Rie ten acres of upland lying upon the pyne plain
parted from the meadow of Edmund Goodnow by a highway, & the same to
a water called Crouton road.

1646. Granted to Henry Rie 4 acres of meadow lying in the Gulte between
meadow of Thomas Goodnow & John Blandford. Also one acre for
allowance lying on the West Brooke between the meadow of John Moor
& the meadow of John How. Also one acre of upland at his now dwelling
house adjoining to the land of John Bore on the South-side of it.

Also one acre & a half of upland lying upon the hill parted from the household
by the highway & the land formerly granted to Edmund Rie
the land of John Maynard.

1658 Also granted and layd out unto Henry Rie in the year 1658 one hundred and
thirty acres of land to it more or less in the two miles of land last granted
the town of Sudbury. being the one and thirtieth lot in his possession
and lying in the third squadron of lots being bounded on the north by
the land granted unto the heirs of Hugh Arifox also bounded on the
south by the lands of John Rie, also bounded at the east end by
the middle highway and second squadron of lots also bounded at the
west end by the widows.

We the subscribers in behalf of the Town of Sudbury
and Acton having been legally appointed for the purpose
met and perambulated the lines and assured the
bounds between said Towns to the satisfaction of both
parties on the Law directs
