land of John Wood & the house lott of John Rutter.

Also Granted and laid out in the year 1668 unto John Rutter of Sudbury
one hundred and thirty acres of upland and meadow in the two miles of land that
granted the town of Sudbury the said one hundred and thirty acres of land and
meadow be it more or less is the thirty six lot in his possession and lying in the
third square being bounded on the north by the lands of John Woods and
also bounded on the south by the land of Solomon Gouson & also bounded
at the west end by the meadows and bounded at the east end by the mill
zigzag way and for the square of lots the lines of the said lot of land
running nearest East East and West North and South having a fresh pond
of water near the middle of the said lot
