

his householl rentyng by estimation fourt acres or there about to the
same more or less lyng betwene the householl of John Went &
the householl of the widow Hunt.

Also a parcell of upland rentyng by estimation sixt acres or
there about to the same more or less lyng on a neck of land betwene
Lyndeswode and on the Eloude ffarm next adjoyning to the lande
of John Goodnowe on one side & the meadow of the Eloude on the
other side.

Also thre acres and a halfe of meadow to the same more or less lyng
in the great ruder meadow betwene the meadow of John Went and
the widow Hunt.

Also seaven acres of meadow to the same more or less lyng
in the great ruder meadow betwene the meadow of John Blandford
and John Hayme.

Laid out formerly & lately due to him in parte of his second & third division
four acres of upland lyng upon the middle parte of his second
division of upland & joyned to the lande of Thomas fflyn now in the possession
of William Browne. his four acres of wile John Cutler and his grise for the year 1666

Also Eloude acres of upland & a halfe betwene the same more or less lyng
upon the south side of the householl joyning to the lande of Robert Dant on
the north east side. wile his third division of upland.

Also an acre & a halfe of upland betwene the same more or less joyning to the
householl lyng betwene the householl of the widow Hunt now in the possession
of John Smith, And the lande granted to John Went now in the possession
of John Cutler wile was parte of his second division of upland.

Also the town granted unto John wood a swampe, six acres or there about
betwene the same more or less lyng on the west side of the ruder joyning to the
householl of the lande of William Corley, senior, and the other third wayd compassed
round wile the hill & the highway that parte it from the great ruder meadow.

Also laid out unto John wood five acres & a quarter of meadow lyng in
the gulfe, and lyng betwene the meadow formerly granted to Thomas Whit
now in the possession of Philomena wile, & the meadow of William Ward
wile is his third division of meadow.

Also thre acres of meadow betwene the same more or less lyng upon the
west side betwene the meadow of the wile & the meadow of
William Browne wile was allowed to his third division of meadow.

Also four acres & a quarter of meadow laid out to John wood wile was
the third division of meadow due to Henry Went, And lyng in part meadow
on the west side of the River & joyned to the west side of the meadow
of William Corley.

Also two acres of meadow betwene the same more or less lyng in the meadow
betwene the meadow of Edmund Goodnowe & the meadow granted
to John ffrothman now in the possession of Josiah Hayme wile was an

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allowance to the third division of meadow granted to Henry ffrothman
Also granted and laid out unto John woods in the year 1666 one hundred and thirty
acres of land be it more or less in the two miles of land last granted the town
of Sudbury, the sayd one hundred and thirty acres of land is the thirty first lot
and thirty in the third squadron having the land of John Cutler on the south
and the lands of his servant Cicoburne on the north being bounded at
the west end by the widows and also bounded at the east end by the
middle of the way.
