

his houseleott containing by estimation six acres or there about be the same more or lesse lying between the houseleott of John Wood and the rydders waye

Also two acres of upland on the pyndhill be the same more or lesse lying to the dwellinge house of the said John Went

Also fifteen acres and a halfe of upland be the same more or lesse lying on a necke of land betweene Tymber north and myr Glouster farme and lying between the lande of John Layme and Edmond Goodnowe.

Also three acres of upland lying on the westside of the river lying to the land of Edmond Goodnowe.

Also five acres of upland be the same more or lesse lying upon pynd playne.

Also seven acres of meadow be the same more or lesse lying in the great river meadowe between the meadowe of John Wood and the rydders waye

Also fourteene acres of meadow be the same more or lesse lying in the great river meadowe betweene the meadowe of John Magnard and Thomas white

Also twenty three acres of upland be the same more or lesse lying between the bene common and the lande of Edmond Reid

Also four acres of meadowe lying in west meadowe on the westside of the river lying between the meadowe of Thomas Catebrad and the meadowe of quilliam Corlowe

The two feodral parcell of upland above named that is to say three acres lying on the westside of the river lying to the land of Edmond Goodnowe. And also the fyve acres of upland lying upon pynd playne the said John Went hath exchanged wth Edmond Goodnowe for a p^{ar}cell of upland containing ten acres and a halfe or there about lying on a necke of land betweene Tymber north and myr Glouster farme and lying to the abovesayd fifteen acres of upland of the said John Went.

Also graunted to John Went ten acres of meadowe be the same more or lesse lying in partur meadowe betweene the meadowe due to John stont for his third division now in the possession of John Mount of the meadowe of John Cuddeshe. & runs northward in a straight of meadowe to a marked tree w^{ch} parteth it from John Wlandfords meadowe this is John Wente third division of meadowe.

Also graunted and layd out to John Went in the year 1658 one hundred and thirty acres of land in the two miles last granted &c. town of fudbury beinge by the river and to the ch^{urch} and lying in the fourth west and fourth square of land of the land of John Went on the north and the land of Thomas Goodnowe on the south butting on the west upon the rydders waye and first square of land butting on the east upon the middle &c. waye and first square of land
