 Daniel Bouker & Aaron Hayns Begining as followeth Viz. at a
 Small Pine Tree Being the Northwest Corner of a piece of Land
 Situate & Lying at the westerly End of the Cedar Swamp & is in the
 possession of the said Aaron Hayns, from thence running South to
 a Heap of Stones Being the Southwest Corner of the said Hayns Land
 from thence a straight Line (a Cross the Road leading from
 Henry Smiths to the west Meetinghouse) Through Land Belong
 = ing to Ebenezer Puffor to a heap of Stones Being the North
 = west Corner of Land in the possession of Jotham Brown from
 thence Between the Land of said Brown & the Land of John
 Maynard Jr. Two Rods wide Being Land that was left for
 a way Untill it Comes to a Road laid out in the year 1703
 for Thomas Smith as may Appear by the Town Book of
 Records the Marke are on the Easterly Side said way
 the said way is Two Rods wide Being Land left by the
 Town (Excepting Through the Land of m^r. Ebenezer Puffors)
 also wee have made an Alteration in the way formerly
 laid out for m^r. Thomas Smith Viz. Begining at the
 Northeast Corner of the Lot (formerly m^r. John Balcoms)
 Running North through Land now in Possession of Daniel
 Bouker a straight Line as his wall now stands Untill
 it Comes into said way againe (cutting a small Elbow in
 said old way & he the said Daniel Bouker is Content to
 Take the Old way so far in Liew thereof & said way is Two
 Rods wide on the Easterly Side of said wall
