

Sudbury May the 4th 1796 —

We the Subscribers being a Committee appointed, to preambulate the Line between the Town of Sudbury & East Sudbury & to Renew the bound which is as follows Viz Beginning at the River opposite ~~the road~~ to bound back up the River to Baldwins Ditch up said Ditch to Stand Road, across ~~S. Road~~ Road to a Stake & Stones, so on the Westerly Side of S. Road to Carters Corner to a Stake & Stones, then Westerly on Carters Ditch to the Corner of the Widow Wheelers Land to a Stake & Stones, then Southwardly to a Stake & Stones Near Brown Shop, then on the Westerly Side of S. Road to a Stake & Stones opposite to the Old training field so called, then a Stake & Stones to the Sandy Hill so called, then Southerly across said Road to a Stake & Stones, and on to a White oak tree Marked in Capt. Mosers Mywards Meadow, so on to a Stake & Stones Near Elijah balorn Passer, then on to a Stake & Stones formerly on Capt. Mosers Stones Woodland, so on a straight Line to a Stake & Stones on the Bank of the River, up the River to Framingham Line to a Stake & Stones on the Westerly Side of the River, Beginning at the Northwesterly corner of the training field so called, at a Stake & Stones, then South east on said field to a Stake & Stones, then turning on said field Southwest to a Stake & Stones, then on to said road to a Stake & Stones, beginning Northwesterly Side, of said Caleb Wheelers farm Between Ephraim Carter, & Caleb Wheelers, to a Stake & Stones, so on S. Line to a Maple tree Marked, the corner of Caleb Wheelers Land, then turning Southerly to a Large Black oak tree Marked, then on Goodnows Wheelers Land to a Stake & Stones, then turning on Mary Willies Land Westerly, to a Stake & Stones Near the Meadow, then Northwesterly to a Stake & Stones, then turning Northwesterly on Michs Goodnows & said Wheelers Line, to said Wheelers Barn to a Stake & Stones.
