Also twenty acres of upland lying upon timber necks adjoin-
ing to the land of Mr Peter Hoyle. cutting Eastward to
the river and eastward to the common.

Also fifteen acres of upland lying upon pine land adjoining
upon the east side to the land of Edmund Goodnow & the west
side lying to the common.

Also thirty acres of meadows lay out by the appointment
of the town by Mr Wendleton & Edmund Goodnow lying
in the west meadows on the south side of the brook adjoining to
the meadows of Mr Herbert Wolham at the Judyan bridge &
on the north side of the brook to the meadows of John Maynard
at the east end and at the west end of it joined to the meadows
of widow Gunt on both sides of the brook

We the subscribers Selectmen of the Town of Sudbury
and East Sudbury Met by appointment and preconcerted
the lines and renewed the bounds between said Towns to
the mutual satisfaction of both parties according to law
and we find the white oak tree in the wood land of William
Hurd is gone we there put a stake and stone also at
the River we erected a stake & stone the tree being dead
otherwise the boundaries as before also the Wholen Farm
so called and Training field excepting the bounds on the brow of
the hill of said Training field were not to be found
