Smith land thence Southwesterly to a stone monument at the road
near Harman Smith thence still Southwesterly to a stone monument at the
road opposite the house of Jonathan Puffers thence still Southwesterly to a
stone monument on the plain near John Carr thence still
Southwesterly to a stone monument at the road East of Lewis Goodnows
thence still Southwesterly to a stone monument at the corner of Sudbury
Marlborough and Stow
