

We the Subscribers being duly appointed to preambulate the line and renew the bounds between the Town of Sudbury and Stow having met and renewed the bounds as follows

- 1st A heap of Stones in Haman Smith Land
- 2^d A heap of Stones by a Stump near the River in Levi Smith Land
- 3^d A heap of Stones at the foot of the hill in Col Rees pasture near a granite rock
- 4th A heap of Stones the east side of the wall on the top of the Hill in said Rees Land
- 5th A heap of Stones in Jonathon Puffer's Land
- 6th A heap of Stones on a Stump near the corner of Daniel Puffer Land
- 7th A heap of Stones by the fence between Daniel Puffer and Jon^a. Puffer's Land
- 8th A pine Stump with Stones on it near the wall at the north side of the Swamp
- 9th A large white pine tree marked
- 10th A pine Stump with Stones on it
- 11th A pitch pine tree marked on the southerly side of the Swamp
- 12th A Stake and Stones at the corner of Daniel Puffer Land
- 13th A pitch pine tree fell down with a heap of Stones at the north
- 14th A heap of Stones on the South side of the road leading from Northborough to Sudbury
- 15th A pitch pine tree at the corner of Sudbury Stow and Northborough
