Granted to Joseph Moor by the major part of the proprietors of y^e town
of Sudbury and lay out by Deacon John Hamor and vestry men
Joseph Curtel and Thomas Knap according to y^e tenor and Eight
Acres of Land bee thereunto more or less lying on both sides of a
Brook that Runneth out of a spruce Swamp that lyeth on the
nor east side of the town of Sudbury joyning to the land formerly
of John Moor his father and now in y^e possession of Joseph Moor the sd
eight acres of meadow land the town hath Granted to Joseph Moor
and his heirs and assigns for Ever this grant you will find entered
in the town booke of orders in folio 9. 10
