with y^e Proprietors of this Town Which land was formerly
granted to John Putter and sold to Joseph Mores and he layd it down
which sd land lay near to the three ponds known by that name

This pice of Land Contayned foure acres and a halfe More or less according to
the Bouds are as followeth begineth at the lower end ^{road} of the wast water
and so five rods south east only and from a pine stump to a stake five rods south
ward from his old bounds to a stake and from thence East ward four and twenty
fod to a stake in a pine tree And from thence three score and ten fods to his old
corner bounds a Crooked whit oak and from thence east ward twenty four
fods East only to a whit oak by a Swamps side his Corner mark
And from thence North ward twenty four rods to an Elm tree marked for
a corner mark and from thence to thirty four rods west only to a whit oak
Marked in his old bounds for a Corner Mark

This was marked out by us the towns Commity appointed by y^e proprietors
