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The select men of Judbury of Day and year above sd upon
y^e Request of Joseph Dean of Judbury for a highway from his
dwelling house to town: have laid out a high way one Rod and
half wide beginning att western line and soe running in a lott
formerly laid out to y^e Right of William parker: y^e high way
to be on y^e south side of y^e lott: through y^e sd lott only att y^e
hill y^e way is to wind att y^e sd hill as y^e land will allow
y^e way is to be three Rods wide from western line to y^e
house of y^e sd Joseph Dean: and then but on Rods and half
through y^e lott on y^e south of y^e lott as above sd: The select
men have laid out this high way provided y^e sd Joseph
Dean pay and satisfie y^e owner of y^e land: for y^e land
And put y^e town to No Cost to mend y^e high way:

Whereas Application being made to y^e select men of Judbury by Jurj
James Brewer and several other inhabitants on y^e East side Judbury
River for a high way to y^e River meadow lotts: Accordingly we y^e
select men being met: beginning as followeth: beginning att
Concord Road and soe betwix y^e house and barn of Jurj James
Brewer as y^e path now goeth: and soe to y^e land of Daniel moor
Then turning westward by y^e land of Daniel moor: to y^e land
that was formerly Capt moors: and soe through a corner of land
formerly Capt moors land: to y^e land in y^e possession of Zachariah
Maynard: and soe on Maynard line in James moors land to
y^e River meadow lotts: we y^e select men of Judbury joyntly Conclude
that y^e way is laid out two Rods wide through out: It is Concluded
by y^e select men: that y^e owners of y^e lands that y^e way goeth through
shall have Liberty to hang sufficient Gates for Carts to pass:
