The Select men of Judbury att y^e Request of Jonathan Rice and several other Inhabitants of y^e westerly part of said Town: have laid out a high way in maner as followeth: viz Beginning at y^e Land of Richard Taylor: and Johnathan Smith running Easterly through y^e Land of Amos Smith: betw^{en} his house and barn: to y^e Thirty Rods high way: Two Rods wide And from y^e End of y^e Land of Richard Taylor Easterly: from y^e Thirty Rod high way: and through part of y^e Land of Simeon John Balcom: and Joseph Balcom: And then through y^e Land of Amos Smith: Then through lands of Jonathan Rice till it Comes to y^e Jernwork meadow: and then partly through y^e meadow of y^e Jonathan Rice: and partly through y^e meadow of Sam^l Willis: And from thence through upland of y^e said Sam^l Willis: and then through Deacon John Claps Land: And then through Land of y^e said Sam^l Willis: and then through Common Land: and from thence through Land Claimed by Capt. Hopst^l Brown: Then through Land Claimed by Nathaniel Rice: and Jonathan Grent: The said high way is laid out by a line of fress markt all on y^e Southwesterly side of said way: and by y^e North Easterly Corner of y^e said Sam^l Willis Barn: the said high way to be two Rods wide all the way except through y^e Jernwork meadow and thars one Rod wide

At the Desire of Daniel Woodward of Judbury for a high way from his Land into Lancaster Road to Go to meeting and market and w^h the subscribers meet at Daniel Woodward: and ordered that the high way from Daniel Woodward Land shall be where the path Now Goeth and a Cro^{ss} the little brook and so on all the way as the path Goes: two Rods wide in Land Called the Thirty Rods high way till it Comes to Ebenezer porveys Land and Entering porveys Land at a whit oak: tree: the high way Goes on the East side of said tree and so on the East side of marked trees all the way two Rods wide till it Comes to Lancaster Road about forty Rods in said porvey Land
