Concord Road.

The select men of sd town then meet: And laid out the high
ways as followeth: Beginning att the high way: laid out by the select
men of Judbury by Corp Saml Abbutts: and into Concord Road:
Beginning at the North side of the hill next to Abbutts a pine tree marked
on the North Easterly side of sd way: And so the high way is Laid out
where the Cart path now Goes and on the south westerly side of marked
trees: till it Comes to Concord Road: and so Crossing said Road and
still on the south westerly side of marked trees over the brook below
the old ^{saw} mill belonging to Benjamin and John moore: and still on
the south westerly side of marked trees between the land of
Jonathan Griffon: and on between the land of said Griffon and the
land of Ephriam Curtis: and so the way Goes on the south westerly side
of marked trees all the way till it Comes to Thomas Cuttings and so
between the land of Thomas Cutting and the land of Daniel Doren and so ^{by} the
land of Thomas Allen and still on the south westerly side of marked trees
till it Comes to a pine tree marked against the Corner of Randal
Davises land and still on between the land of Zebadiah Allen:
and the land of Elisha Rice: as the fence now stands: till it Comes
into the Road Going by Elisha Rices to weston: and the aforesaid
high way is no place less then two Road wide and the Rest of the way
to be three or four Rods wide as the proprietors of Judbury left the
land for a high way: Also laid out a high way from Concord Road
by the side of Ephriam Curtises said as the Cart path now Goes
between the land of Capt Ephriam Curtis and the land of said Curtis
and Thomas moor: and so on as the Cart path now Goes between
the land of Thomas moor and the land of Jonathan Griffon: by the
Dwelling House of Thomas moor: and the Dwelling House of
Jonathan Griffon: and so on as the Cart path now Goes between
the land of Jonathan Griffon and the land of Thomas moor
and so on between Griffon lands till it Comes into the above
